A FRENCH COURT DECISION PROTECTS EHS* PHILIPPE TRIBAUDEAU FROM EVICTION

The decision of the Dignes les Bains judicial court, through its referee's order of February 22, 2024, recognises the right to Housing In Situ and the right to the respect for health, in regard to the manifestation of extreme electrohypersensitivity.

This is great news! The Association Zones Blanches (AZB), created by the French Member of European Parliament Michèle RIVASI, welcomes this decision, which protects Philippe TRIBAUDEAU from eviction and contributes to the recognition of electrohypersensitive people.

"The judge reminds that the right to property is neither general nor absolute, and that it must be conciled with the right to health. He underlines the responsibility of the State to ensure the right to housing for its citizens, and the right to respect their health. This decision is for me a recognition of electrohypersensitivity and toxicity of waves" stated EHS Philippe TRIBAUDEAU, member of the Board of Directors of AZB, following the announcement of this judgment.

Refugee for 9 years, in a white zone free of any electrosmog, belonging to the private domain of the State, threatened with eviction by the National Forests Office (ONF), Philippe TRIBAUDEAU has just won a first major fight in his standoff against the installation of a relay antenna near his living place.

Facing the arguments of the ONF, which requested the expulsion of Philippe TRIBAUDEAU on the grounds of an unlawful public disorder; Philippe TRIBAUDEAU reminded the 1st article of the Charter for the Environment, a text of constitutional value integrated into French Law in 2005, which affirms "the right to live in a balanced environment that respects health", EHS included !

Facing the lack of implementation of suitable rehousing proposed by the State, the right to health of individuals also defined by the Declaration of Human Rights, the accord relating to economic, social and cultural rights as well as the convention relating to the rights of people with disabilities was also applied.

Association Zones Blanches is pleased to have supported Philippe TRIBAUDEAU with this first court decision which recognises and protects electrohypersensitive people by the State.
